# Trinity College & St Patrick's Cathedral



Today you will visit Trinity College and St Patrick's Cathedral. Trinity College was founded by Elizabeth I in 1592, Trinity is the sole college of Dublin University. The Old Library houses some 200,000 of the college's collection of more than 2 million volumes. The most priceless manuscript it has is the Book of Kells, a Latin text of the Four Gospels with illuminated pages, which dates from about AD 800.

Travel down Dame Street to visit St Patrick's Cathedral. Jonathan Swift, the author of Gulliver's Travels was once the dean in this Cathedral and today Swift's tomb is in the south aisle. This cathedral is one of the finest examples of Gothic Architecture in Dublin.

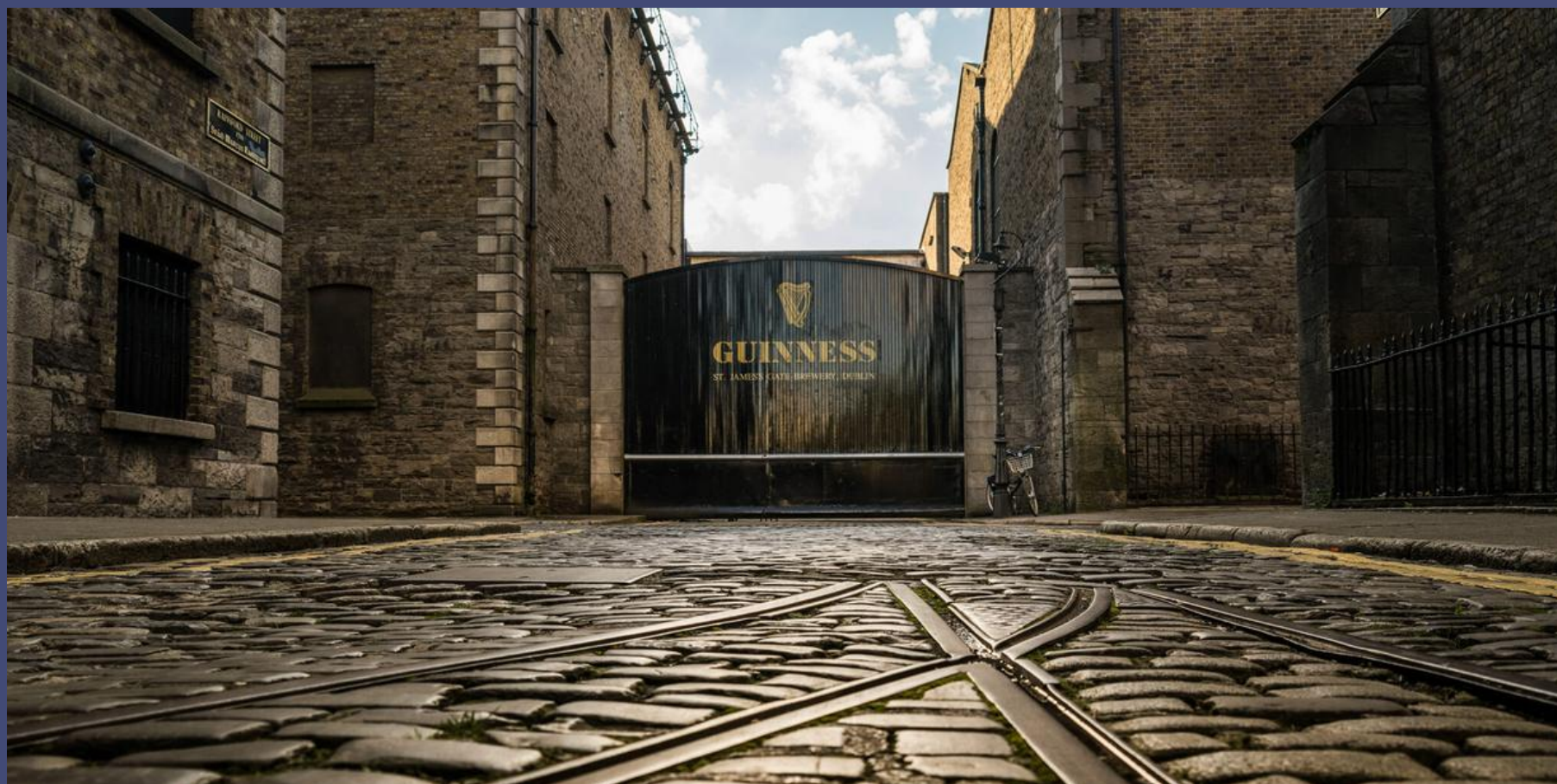

# Golf at the Royal Dublin Golf Club



Founded in 1885 by Mr. John Lumsden, The Royal Dublin Golf Club is steeped in golfing history and presents a stern golfing examination on a truly magnificent links course and is widely accepted as one of the greatest links courses in the world. The links was originally designed by H.S.Colt, the world famous golf architect from Sunningdale. Since the Irish Open was first held here in 1894, the Royal Dublin has hosted in excess of 50 professional and amateur championships. These championships have attracted some of the best players in the world to Dollymount.

The Royal Dublin Golf Club hosted The Carrolls Irish Open from 1983-1985 with Seve Ballesteros winning in 1983 and 1985 and Bernhard Langer winning in 1984. The Club has also regularly hosted the Irish Amateur Close and the Irish PGA.

# North Dublin Coast and Malahide Castle
